Teen Intervene is an evidence-based brief intervention program for youth ages 12-19 years old suspected of experiencing mild to moderate problems associated with alcohol and/or other substance use. The program may also include the participation of teens' parents or guardians. Teen Intervene program integrates stages of change theory, motivational interviewing, and cognitive-behavioral therapy to help teens reduce and ultimately eliminate their alcohol and/or substance use. Teen Intervene is included in the National Registry of Evidence-Based Programs and Practices (NREPP) as an evidenced based prevention program.

Who should attend?

Teen Intervene is designed for trained professionals, including teachers, school counselors, social workers, psychologists, etc. and other youth-serving professionals who are working with substance-abusing teenagers. Users of the Teen Intervene model should have formal training in basic counseling skills, as well as a basic understanding of the etiology, course, and treatment of adolescent substance abuse. This training is appropriate for staff working in the prevention, treatment, mental health, probation, juvenile justice, etc. fields.

Cost: \$35 a participant
